A Rootd Bushcraft trip is about thriving and forming a deeper connection with nature, combining outdoor education with personal development.

Unplugged from screens and away from the distractions of technology and the classroom, students are encouraged to step outside their comfort zones, promoting resilience and self-confidence. Learning essential survival skills such as fire-making, shelter building, knife skills, and outdoor cooking methods fosters teamwork and problem solving skills.

Introducing children to the wonders of the natural world through activities like foraging, learning to recognise animal tracks, and navigating by natural signs like the stars or sun leads to a deeper appreciation for nature and the environment.
